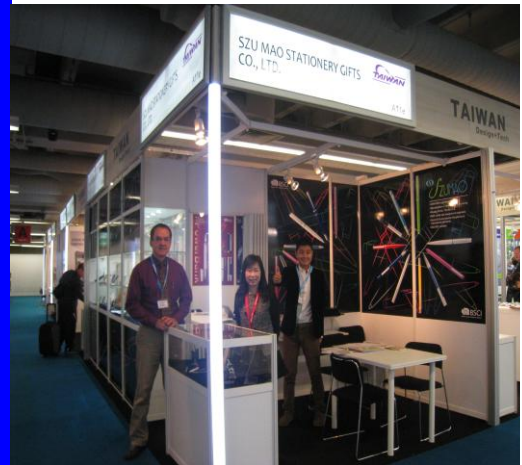

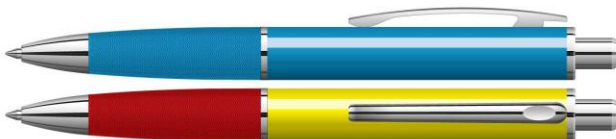

News from China

China's one-child policy to end

China will allow two children for every couple, the state-run Xinhua news agency recently reported, a move that would effectively dismantle the remnants of the country's one-child policy.

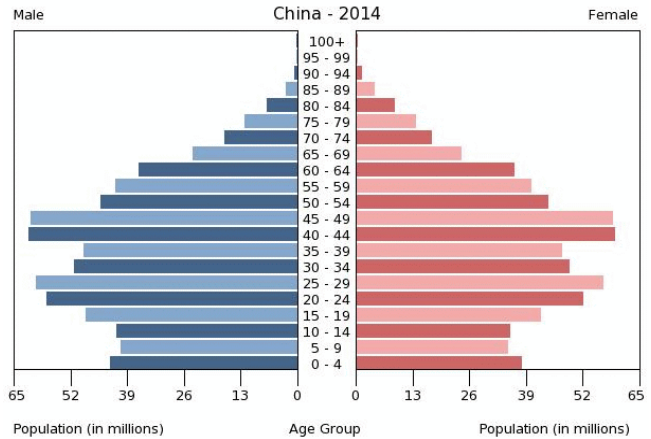
China, now a nation of more than 1.3 billion people, instituted a policy of one child per couple in the late 1970s to control population growth.

"China will implement the policy of 'One Couple, Two Children' in a proactive response to the issue of an aging population.

"To promote a balanced growth of population, China will continue to uphold the basic national policy of population control and improve its strategy on population development."

In 2013, the one-child policy was relaxed to allow some families, a reported 11 million couples, to have a second child. But only ~one million couples applied to have a second child in 2014, less than half the expected number.

"A survey by a government commission found only about half of eligible couples wish to have two children, due to the cost of living impact of a second child."



China's Economy

China's economy is now ~60% the size of the USA's

China: \$10,357 **USA: \$17,348** (nominal GDP. Billion USD)

GDP 2015 growth rate: **China 6.8%** **USA: 2.60%**

GDP 2015 increase: **China \$704** **USA: \$451** (billion USD)

China's increase in GDP will be ~1.6x that of the USA for 2015

Note: GDP numbers are from International Monetary Fund. Figures are nominal GDP, not PPP (purchasing power parity.)
